The National Direct Drug List is a list of prescription medications approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). We've reviewed these drugs through our Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Process, which considers a drug's:

- Effectiveness
- Safety
- Similarity to other drugs within a therapeutic class
- Affordability

The National Drug Direct List is an open drug list or formulary, with some closed drug classes. The list includes a broad range of drug choices — including 97.5% of all prescription medications.\* If a medication is not on the list, there are other high-quality, cost-effective choices, called preferred alternatives, that are.

Medications not included on the National Direct Drug List are shown on the chart included here, along with their preferred alternatives that are on the list. Please note,

exclusions and limitations may apply. For details about what's covered and what's not, it's best to check the Certificate/Evidence of Coverage or Summary Plan Description.
